

RESOLUTION NO. R-77-25

WHEREAS, Conway Memorial Hospital provides health care to residents of both the City of Conway and Faulkner County as a whole at equal rates; and

WHEREAS, the Residents of the City of Conway have, in the past, provided the tax monies necessary to construct the present hospital facility; and

WHEREAS, Conway Memorial Hospital facility is presently inadequate in regard to hospital support facilities; and

WHEREAS, the hospital board has formulated a State approved support facility expansion project to correct these inadequacies with said project capable of being initiated within the time frame established by the Local Public Works program guidelines; and


WHEREAS, the Hospital must obtain \$500,000 dollars in outside funding to initiate this proposed 2.3 million dollar expansion project.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS, that said Council both recognized the urgency of need and formally endorses this proposed hospital improvement project; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Conway, Arkansas hereby formally requests that the Quorum Court of Faulkner County provide this outside funding, in the amount of \$500,000 dollars, by both allocating a like amount from the Faulkner County Round II Local Public Works target figure of \$1,052,000 dollars and endorsing this project.
