FIREWORKS

7.16.01 Firing of regulated. The discharge, firing or use of firecrackers, rockets, torpedoes, roman candles, or other fireworks or substances designed and intended for pyrotechnic display, and of pistols, canes, cannons, or other appliances, using blank cartridges or caps containing chlorate of potash mixture, is hereby prohibited. Provided, however, that the mayor or city council may order the public display of fireworks by properly qualified individuals. Provided, also that such display or displays shall be of such character and so located, discharged or fired as, in the opinion of the chief of the fire department shall not be hazardous to surrounding property or endanger any person or persons. 7.16.02 Sale of prohibited. The sale of fireworks at retail is hereby prohibited. The chief of the fire department may, at his discretion, remove or have removed, at the owner's expense, all stocks of fireworks or other combustibles exposed for sale, or held in violation hereof. (Ord. No. A-61, Sec. 2)

7.16.03 Penalty. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of Sections 7.16.01 - .02 shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof be fined in any sum of not less than Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00). Each retail transaction may be considered a separate offense. (Ord. No. O-01-67, Sec. 1)
