

ORDINANCE NO. A-341

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN PORTIONS OF SECTION SIX (6) OF ORDINANCE NO. A-334 OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS: DECLARING AN EMERGENCY: AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Section Six (6), Sub-section (D), of Ordinance No. A-~~334~~²³⁴ of the City of Conway, Arkansas, adopted the, 25 day of November, 1958, is hereby amended to read as follows, to-wit:

(D) "Specialist Sign Electrician" is defined to include any individual engaged in the business of building, erecting, maintaining and repairing electrically illuminated or operated signs, and gaseous tubing for illuminations, making all connections on secondary side of transformers and primary connections only where there is an outlet of sufficient capacity available within fifteen feet of the sign or transformer to be connected.

SECTION 2. Section Six (6), Sub-section (E) of said Ordinance No. A-334 of said City is hereby amended to read as follows, to-wit:

(E) "Specialist Refrigeration Electrician" is defined to include any individual engaged in the business of servicing, maintaining, repairing and installing electrical equipment in connection with refrigeration providing they do not make final connections to electric current unless there is an approved outlet of sufficient capacity available within 15 feet of the machine to be connected,

SECTION 3. Section Six (6), Sub-section (H) of said Ordinance No. A-334 of said City is hereby amended to read as follows, to-wit:

(H) "Electrical Sign Contractor" is defined to include any person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of manufacture, installation, erection and repair of electrically illuminated or operated signs. They shall be entitled to install the tubing for illumination or interior gaseous tube lighting and to make final connection between the transformer secondary wiring and the tube electrode. The primary connection to transformers and signs can be made provided there is an outlet of sufficient capacity available within 15 feet of the sign or transformer to be connected. The actual work shall be done by a qualified master, journeyman.

SECTION 4. Section Six (6), Sub-section (I) of said Ordinance No. A-334 of said City is hereby amended to read as follows, to-wit:

(I) "Electrical Refrigeration Contractor" is defined to include any person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of installing, repairing or maintaining electrical equipment in connection with refrigeration.

They shall be entitled to install, maintain and replace electrical equipment, make necessary connections to refrigeration equipment, providing they do not make final connection to electric current unless there is an approved outlet of sufficient capacity available within fifteen feet of the machine to be connected.

SECTION 5. This ordinance being necessary to alleviate certain confusion heretofore existing and for the general welfare of the public, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication,
