Whereas, the City of Conway, Arkansas is not in need of as much  
as fifty feet in width for the right of way and easement for all the  
purposes set out in said Ordinance No. A 154.

Now, Therefore, Be It Ordained By The City Council of  
Conway, Arkansas:

Section 1. That the easement and right of way retained by  
the City of Conway, Arkansas in Section 2 of said Ordinance No.  
A 154 in so far as the same was and is applicable to that portion  
of former Martin Street and now coinciding with said Lot 8-A in  
Block 2, Little Addition to the City of Conway, Arkansas as shown  
on re-plat filed September 4, 1950 and recorded in Book "A" at  
Page 149 of the Plat Records of Faulkner County, Arkansas, be and

the same is hereby forever abandoned, except as to the North Fifteen (15) feet thereof, which coincides with the North 15 feet of said Lot 8-A, and over which ~~is~~ 15 foot strip, said right of way and easement, for all the purposes mentioned and set out in Section 2 of said Ordinance A 154, is hereby specifically retained.

Section 2. A copy of this ordinance, duly certified by the City Clerk of Conway, Arkansas, shall be filed in the office of the Recorder of Deeds of Faulkner County, Arkansas.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
