

ORDINANCE NO. A-4-87

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE VEHICULAR
TRAFFIC ON A PORTION OF FOURTH STREET;
PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION HEREOF;
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. That Fourth Street, from Harkrider Street to Factory Street, in the City of Conway, Arkansas, shall hereafter be a one-way street during the hours from 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m., and from 3:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m., on each of the days Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday of each week in the months of September, October, November, December, January, February, March, April and May, and it shall hereafter be unlawful for any person to operate any motorized vehicle along or upon the aforesaid portion of Fourth Street except from ~~West~~^{East} to ~~East~~^{West} during the times hereinabove set out.

SECTION 2. Any person violating this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not less than \$5.00, nor more than \$25.00.

SECTION 3. This ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Conway, Arkansas, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and publication.
