

ORDINANCE NO. 0-75-2

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF INSURING ATTENDANCE
AT ALL REGULAR MEETINGS OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF CONWAY,
ARKANSAS: DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY,
ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1: For the purpose of insuring attendance at all
regular meetings, a member of the City Council of Conway, Arkansas
will forfeit \$50.00 for each absence without cause.

SECTION 2: Cause shall mean illness which confines the member
to home or hospital, or any absence from the City due to an emergency.


SECTION 3: Three absences shall be allowed each City Council
member for any one calendar year without fine for the purpose of
business or vacation.

SECTION 4: Notice of intended absence shall be filed with
the City Clerk, who shall keep a log of attendance. Fines shall
be collected by the City Clerk and kept in a special fund for a
purpose to be determined by the Council as a whole.

SECTION 5: This ordinance, being necessary for the public
safety and welfare, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and
this ordinance shall be enforced and shall take effect from and
after its passage and publication.
