

ORDINANCE NO. 0-75-4

AN ORDINANCE PREVENTING PARKING OF
AUTOMOBILES IN ALLEYWAYS IN THE
CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS: DECLARING
AN EMERGENCY: AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY,
ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1: No person shall park a vehicle within an alley in any manner whatsoever unless said vehicle is loading or unloading merchandise from or into any business opening onto or adjoining said alley, and in that event, said vehicle is not to remain in said alley for any length of time greater than is reasonably necessary for the loading or unloading of merchandise and goods as aforesaid.

SECTION 2: Any person, firm or corporation who shall violate or permit, suffer, or allow anyone under his, their or its direction or control to violate Section 1 of this ordinance, or aid, abet or assist in the violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be fined to any sum of not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$21.00 for each offense.


SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the ordinance set forth above are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: In the event any word, phrase, clause, sentence or any part of the ordinance set forth above is declared unconstitutional, void or illegal, then all remaining portions of said ordinance not so declared illegal, unconstitutional, void or illegal, are to remain valid and in full force and effect.

SECTION 5: This ordinance being necessary for the public safety and welfare, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be enforced and shall take effect from and after its passage and publication.
