AN ORDINANCE RE-ZONING PROPERTY FROM B-3
to B-4, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND FOR
ALL OTHER PURPOSES:

BE ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS:


Section 1: That from and after the passage and publication
of this ordinance the hereinafter described property will be
re-zoned from B-3 to B-4, to-wit:

Article
A parcel of land fronting on Highway 64 East,
in Conway, Arkansas being 165 feet wide on the
Highway and 565 feet deep, more **particularly**
described as the North part of the W $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 8, T5N, R13W, less the Highway
right-of-way, Faulkner County, Arkansas.
Located East of Ramada Inn.


SECTION 2: This ordinance, being necessary for the
