

ORDINANCE 0-77- 4

AN ORDINANCE DESCRIBING PROCEDURE FOR THE INSTALLATION AND / OR REMOVAL OF TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES IN THE CITY LIMITS OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That from and after the passage and publication of this ordinance the following procedure must be followed for the installation and/or removal of all traffic control devices in the City of Conway, Arkansas:

1. That any individual or city agency desiring or requesting the installation and/or removal of a traffic control device in the city limits of Conway, Arkansas must present a proposal to the City Police ~~Commission~~ ^{Committee} and the City Council setting forth what type of devices that are to be installed or removed and the reason therefore.

2. That the Police Committee is to meet together, and make a recommendation to the full Council as soon as is possible after the proposal is presented to them. Recommendation of said committee is to be either that the proposal be granted or that the proposal be denied, or no recommendation.


3. That if the Council as a whole ^{Ac} ~~re~~ accepts the proposal, by a majority of its members on a roll call vote, the appropriate agency is to be notified of the action of the Council with directions to either install or remove the requested traffic control devices. If the Council rejects the proposal, the proposing party is to be notified by mail of the decision of the Council.

Section 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances that conflict herewith are hereby specifically ~~re~~ ^{re}pealed.


Section 3 : It being necessary for the protection of the public peace, safety health and welfare, that an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and publication.
