AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS; DECLARING SUCH TERRITORY TO BE A PART OF SAID CITY; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, Aubrey J. Baker and wife, Shirley Baker, and Huey Smith and wife, Dorothy Smith, who have filed petitions in the County Court of Faulkner County, Arkansas, for the annexation into the City of Conway, Arkansas, of the hereinafter described lands, are more than fifty percent of the owners in number and own more than fifty percent in acreage of said lands; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 77-43, dated November 22, 1977, the City Council of the City of Conway, Arkansas, declared its willingness to accept the hereinafter described lands as a part of the City of Conway, Arkansas; and

WHEREAS, after proceedings being had upon notice by publication, all as provided by and in accordance with the laws of the State of Arkansas, the Judge of the County Court of Faulkner County, Arkansas, did, on January 23, 1978, enter his order of annexation to said City of the hereinafter described lands.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1: That the City Council of Conway, Arkansas, does hereby accept the hereinafter described territory, annexed to said City by order of the County Court of Faulkner County, Arkansas, heretofore entered on January 23, 1978, said territory being described as follows:

The East 7/8 of the South 1/2 of the SE 1/4 of Section 35, Township 6 North, Range 14 West, containing 70 acres, more or less.

And that said above-described lands and territory be, and the same hereby are, declared to be a part of the City of Conway, Faulkner County, Arkansas.

SECTION 2: It is hereby ascertained and declared that it is necessary for the protection and preservation of the public health and safety that the foregoing ordinance be passed and adopted; that an emergency exists; and that this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
