

AN ORDINANCE REVOKING OLD FINES FOR ALDERMEN WHO HAVE UNEXCUSED ABSENCE FROM COUNCIL MEETINGS AND SETTING OF NEW FINES, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES:


BE ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: That the fines as previously established for unexcused absences from the council meeting by Aldermen are hereby repealed.


SECTION 2: Effective with the passage of this Ordinance the fines for unexcused absences as previously defined are to be onehalf ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the monthly salary of said Aldermen for each unexcused absence as previously defined in the prior ordinances.

SECTION 3: It being necessary for the protection and preservation of public health, safety and welfare, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and publication.
