

ORDINANCE NO. 0-80-17

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 4.12.05, 4.12.06 OF THE CONWAY MUNICIPAL CODE: DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. That section 4.12.05 of the Conway Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

4.12.05 Billiards, pool, snooker, operations declared to be a privilege. The operation of any billiard, pool or snooker room or table within the City of Conway, Arkansas, is hereby declared a privilege, and shall be subject to payment of a privilege license as hereafter specified; provided, however, that this ordinance shall not apply to any billiard, pool or snooker tables or rooms in any private residence or in any public building, school or college building, not operated for profit, not open to the public in general, and where no fees are charged for the privilege of playing games on any such billiard, pool or snooker table. Section 2. That section 4.12.06 of the Conway Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

4.12.06 Privilege license. The privilege license specified in Section 4.12.05 shall be in the following amounts:

For the operation of any billiard, pool or snooker rooms, containing not more than five (5) billiard, pool or snooker tables, the sum of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars, and for each additional billiard, pool or snooker table in excess of five (5) tables, the sum of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars per table shall be paid.

Section 3. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed to the extent of the conflict.

Section 4. That there is hereby found and declared to be an immediate need for regulation in this area in order to protect the public health, safety, and welfare. It is, therefore, declared that an emergency exists and this Ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in force and effect immediately upon and after its passage.
