

ORDINANCE NO. 0-81-23

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN LANDS TO THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1: The City of Conway, Arkansas, hereby accepts the hereinafter described territory, annexed to said City by order of the County Court of Faulkner County, Arkansas, heretofore entered on MARCH 14, 1980, and said territory being situated in Faulkner County, Arkansas, and described as follows:

The E 1/2 NW 1/4 and W 1/2 NE 1/4, Section 20, Township 5 North, Range 13 West, less and except part of the E 1/2 NW 1/4 of said Section 20, described as beginning at the southwest corner of said E 1/2 NW 1/4, and running thence north by 02 degrees 09 minutes east along the west line of said E 1/2 NW 1/4 a distance of 769.7 feet to a point on the easterly right-of-way line of Interstate Highway 40; thence south by 13 degrees 04 minutes east along said easterly right-of-way line a distance of 704.3 feet to a point; thence south by 57 degrees 10 minutes east along said right-of-way line a distance of 119.2 feet to a point; thence south by 02 degrees 17 minutes 40 seconds west along said right-of-way line a distance of 30 feet to a point on the south line of said NW 1/4 of said Section 20; thence north by 87 degrees 42 minutes 20 seconds west along said south line a distance of 287.4 feet to the point of beginning, said exception containing 1.97 acre, more or less, and leaving 158.03 acres, more or less,

and that said above-described lands and territory be, and the same hereby are, declared to be a part of the City of Conway, Faulkner County, Arkansas.

SECTION 2: From and after this date, the inhabitants residing within and upon the hereinabove described lands and territory shall have and enjoy all the rights and privileges of, and be subject to all the laws, rules, ordinances, limitations, and regulations imposed upon the inhabitants within the original limits of said City of Conway, Arkansas.

SECTION 3: It is hereby ascertained and declared that it is necessary for the protection and preservation of the public health and safety that the foregoing ordinance be passed and adopted;

that an emergency exists; and that this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
