

ORDINANCE NO. 0-88-10

AN ORDINANCE NAMING A STREET; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1: That the street described below shall be named "Amity Road":

The street that parallels Interstate 40 on the East side, beginning at the Southernmost exit from I-40 within the Conway city limits and running Northerly until it curves to the East to enter Stonebridge Subdivision. When the road curves East to enter Stonebridge Subdivision, the name shall change to Bridgestone.

SECTION 2: That all ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 3: That this ordinance is necessary for the protection of the public peace, health and safety and an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.'
