CONWAY POLICE DEPARTMENT ENTRY LEVEL POLICE OFFICER EXAM

The next test date is October 18, 2008. Please check our website at conwaypd.org for more information.

Photo ID mandatory. Entry test scores are good for one year. The testing will take place at the Conway High School West in the cafeteria. The Conway High School West campus is located at 2300 Prince Street between Donaghey and Farris. **Photo ID mandatory.** Entry Test scores are good for one year or until the next test is given.

Test starts at 8:00 a.m. and no one will be admitted late. You must bring a photo ID. The Physical Agility Testing will be done immediately following the written test so come prepared to change into clothing suitable for strenuous exercise and running.

Candidates must:

1. Be a U.S. Citizen,
2. Have a high school diploma or GED
3. **Not** have any felony convictions or misdemeanor convictions of domestic violence
4. Possess a valid drivers license
5. Be at least 20 ½ years of age and less than 46 years of age on the date of the written exam.
6. Be at least 21 years of age and less than 46 years of age on the date of hire.

Candidates who receive a passing score on the initial exam must also pass the following to be considered for employment:

1. Physical agility test consist of pushing a squad car, running a lap on the track, scaling a 7 foot barrier, running bleachers, striking a dummy and dragging a 150 lb dummy. The test must be completed in 4 minutes and 30 seconds or less. An illustrated break down of the test is posted on our web site under "Join Our Team".
2. Medical and psychological exam
3. Visual acuity test
4. Complete background investigation to include an interview and truth verification exam.

Applications will be available after successful completion of the written and physical agility exams.

Starting pay for an entry level police officer ranges from \$29,144 - \$42,212 annually, depending on previous certified law enforcement experience and level of certification attained. Minimum passing score on the written test is 80%. After scoring 80%, a maximum of 5 Educational/Vocational Qualification points may be awarded for any one of the following attributes:

- Current certified police officer
- Bi-lingual in conversational Spanish or ASL sign language
- 30 or more college credit hours with 2.0 or higher grade point
